Who Does What – A Quick Guide

Advisor

The role of the advisor varies widely at different schools. At Forman, the advisor's primary role is to support the student. They take a big picture, a whole-child approach. They offer advice and counsel to a student, act as an advocate, and help students navigate the normal development of being an adolescent. They can provide you with a holistic picture of your child's development, but if you have a more specific question, such as a poor grade on a math quiz, it is better to reach out to the teacher, dorm parent, or coach directly. Contact your student's specific advisor for concerns or questions related to advising. They are a great first person to go to, and they can either help answer your question or direct you to who the right person would be.

Administrator on Duty

Our switchboard is active from 8:00 a.m.- 4:00 p.m., Monday to Friday. If something urgent occurs outside these hours, please contact the Administrator on Duty (AOD) at 860.601.8543. The AOD phone is answered by one of our administrators at all times of the day or night. If you go to voicemail, it typically means the AOD was on the phone with a different parent. In this case, leave a message, and they will get back to you shortly. We also ask that anytime a boarding student leaves or returns to the campus, they call the AOD. This is critical so that we have an accurate understanding of where each student is at any point. If you have questions about upcoming events or non-urgent matters, please call Monday through Friday during business hours.

Head of School - Amy Clemons
